FROM MINISTER HEATHER

Dear Church Family, February gives us a beautiful gift: Valentine's Day flows right into Ash Wednesday, reminding us that human love points us toward divine love. What if the hearts and flowers aren't separate from ashes and fasting, but part of one seamless story? This February, I invite you to see Lent not as a departure from love, but as a deeper dive into it.

"We love because he first loved us" (1 John 4:19). God's love comes first before we ever thought of Him, He was thinking of us. As we enter Lent, remember: we're not fasting or praying to earn God's love. We're responding to a love already poured out, already given, already secured.

"God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us" (Romans 5:8). God didn't just say He loved us, He proved it at the cross. Notice the timing: while we were still sinners. Jesus didn't die for us because we were lovely; He died to make us lovely. The ashes we receive remind us we are dust that God loves enough to die for.

"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son...not to condemn the world, but to save the world through him" (John 3:16-17). Lent isn't about guilt or condemnation it's about receiving extravagant grace. We confess because we're safe to confess. We repent because we're loved enough to be welcomed home.

Valentine's Day celebrates love with gifts and expressions. Lent responds to love with prayer, fasting, and service. Both are about love, just expressed differently. Lenten practices aren't obligations; they're love responses. When you love someone, you want time with them (prayer), you'll sacrifice for them (fasting), and you serve others in their name (almsgiving).

As we close, I want to leave you with three simple truths to carry into this Lenten season: You are loved. Not because of what you do, but because of who God is. Not because you've earned it, but because He first loved you. Not conditionally, but completely. God's love for you was demonstrated at the cross and is as real today as it was two thousand years ago. You are forgiven. "While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." Your past doesn't disqualify you. Your mistakes don't define you. Your failures don't have the final word. In Christ, you are forgiven, cleansed, and made new. You are sent. God didn't love you and forgive you just so you could feel good. He loved you and forgave you so you could become a conduit of that love to others. You're sent into your family, your workplace, your neighborhood, your community to be a living demonstration of God's love. This February, let the love we celebrate on Valentine's Day flow seamlessly into the love we contemplate during Lent. Let the hearts and flowers remind you of the heart of God and the flower that bloomed from a borrowed tomb. Let the ashes on your forehead be a mark not of condemnation but of belonging. You belong to the God who loved you enough to die for you and who loves you enough to transform you. We love because He first loved us. That's the story of Valentine's Day. That's the story of Lent. That's the story of our lives. May this be our most love-filled Lenten journey yet. In Christ's love, Heather

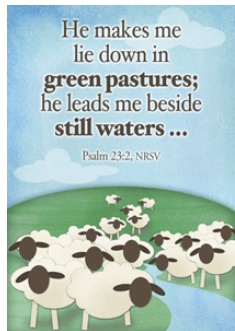
We will start collecting items for the Personal Care Kits during Lent.

ZION CHURCH COUNCIL - JANUARY 4, 2026

Meeting called to order by Curt Schumaier. Minister Heather Feland led a word of prayer.

Read and reviewed the monthly council meeting minutes from the previous meeting. Motion by Chad Schweitzer to approve the minutes as written, Second by Lyle Gorseth. Motion carried.

Discussion: Financial Report and budget were discussed together in new business.

Minister Report:

1. Pastors report – see attached report
2. Heather's paperwork is fully into the seminary for her schooling.

Old Business:

1. Parsonage – Flooring will get completed as soon as a contractor is able to finish the job.
2. Phone line for church and parsonage – SRT landline will stay. The church answering machine message will be changed to have Heather's information so people can call her phone directly. More discussion will take place on the phone and voicemail vs an answering machine.
3. Board of Education – Continued discussion will take place.
4. Applicants for Treasurer, Custodian and Secretary

New Business:

1. Budget – discussion took place. A motion was made by Chad Schweitzer and seconded by Jerry Hennessy to accept the December 25 budget and the 2026 budget. Motion carried.
2. Bids for Treasurer, Secretary and Custodian were read and discussed. A motion was made by Jerry Hennessy to accept the bid by Greg Feland for church custodian at \$500/month and keep Carson Schumaier on as an hourly position to assist in needed projects. Greg will be responsible for all grounds work to parsonage and church. Seconded by Lyle Gorseth. Motion carried. A motion was made by Chad Schweitzer to accept the bid by Kershawn Michel for church secretary at \$650/month. Alechia Neubauer seconded the motion. Motion carried. A motion made by Jerry Hennessy to accept the bid by Kylene Hornberger for church treasurer at \$650/month. Seconded by Marvin Heller. Motion carried.
3. Heather is accepted as the official SAM through December 31, 2026. This paperwork must be submitted annually.
4. 4H quilting club will use the church for their events.
5. Metigoshe Ministries. Continued discussion has taken place and Zion will ask Metigoshe to place us on the Day Camp list for 2026.
6. A motion was made to move the Annual Meeting to February 1 by Jerry Hennessy and seconded by Alechia Neubauer. Motion carried.
7. February 8th will be installation of new council members.

Next Zion Council Meeting will be held on February 8th at noon.

Meeting was adjourned & closed with The Lord's Prayer.
