
FROM MINISTER HEATHER

Happy New Year and Blessings on 2026

As we step into 2026, we celebrate Epiphany – the revelation of Christ to the world through the visit of the Magi. In Matthew 2:1-2, wise men from the east followed a star, asking "Where is the one who has been born king of the Jews?" Their journey reminds us that, as we enter this New Year, we too are called to follow the light – Jesus Christ himself. Just as that divine star guided the Magi to the Christ child, Jesus continues to illuminate our path into 2026 with hope and purpose.



JOINT CHURCH COUNCIL - DECEMBER 7, 2025, 12:00 PM

Attendance: Zion Members present were Kyle Schepp, Marvin Heller, Lyle Gorseth, Klint Hanson, Alechia Neubauer, Curt Schumaier, and Corine Christman.

Carpio Members present were Tammi Moen, Jeff Moen, Lyndon Bloms and Wes Peterson.

Call to Order: Zion President, Curt Schumaier

Old Business: Minister Heather's pay benefits package was discussed.

Annual Salary: \$36,600 effective January 1, 2026 (80% of years of service as recommended by the Western ND Synod)

Health: 100% of single (pastor only) health care coverage.

Parsonage: For tax purposes valued at a monthly rate of \$1500.

Vacation/Sick Leave: 3 weeks' vacation and 2 weeks sick pay. This is a use it lose it policy.

Mileage: Paid per Federal mileage rate. (70 cents is the 2025 rate)

Housing: No housing equity – this will be added when she is fully ordained.

Education: Minister Heather will be reimbursed for continuing education classes, mileage, and hotels.

Klint Hanson motioned to accept the pay and benefits package. Jeff Moen seconded, carried.

New Business: Joint Services when a month has a 5th Sunday. For 2026, this will be March, May, August, and November. March will be at Zion at 9:00, May will be at Carpio at 11:00, August will be at Zion, and November will be at Carpio. Times for August and November to be determined. Lyle Gorseth motioned to have 5th Sunday joint services. Klint Hanson seconded, motion carried.

Licensing for music: Minister Heather is checking into our licensing for music. She is checking into our options and licensing as a parish instead of each church. To be discussed later when more information is available.

Phones at both churches: Both churches will keep their landlines and the message on the answering machine will be changed to include Minister Heather and her cell phone number.

Lay Leaders: We need to find people interested in being a layer person to lead worship when Minister Heather is on vacation or sick. The Secretaries of both churches will be responsible for finding the lay person when needed.

Internet Service: Minister Heather uses Verizon internet service. The SRT internet service at the parsonage will be disconnected and Minister Heather will be reimbursed \$35 for the cost of Verizon internet.

The meeting was closed with The Lord's Prayer.


Another council member will be needed in 2026 as Jeff Moen's service is complete. Lyndon Bloms will become president.
