March has appeared so quickly, I feel as though February was just here and now it is gone. As we enter into the month of March, we are welcomed with the warmth in the air, the sun sparkling in the sky. Even though we don't know what the month will bring, we can be delighted in the knowledge that we will be "Walking with Christ through Lent".

We will begin our journey on March 5th, with Ash Wednesday. It begins by being marked with the sign of the cross, with Ash that has been burned from the palm leaves from previous Palm Sundays. We do this to remind us of our human mortality and the need for repentance. As we read from the verse from Genesis 3:19; By the sweat of your face you shall eat bread until you return to the ground, for out of it you were taken; you are dust, and to dust you shall return."

What do we learn from this? It is that as a consequence of Adam and Eve's disobedience, humans will experience hardship in our labor. Even though we have the need to work hard and are very laborious, we should be highlighting our reliance on God. Even through our hardest days, God always has a way of ensuring we are provided for. As we take this journey through lent, we hear "dust you are, and to dust you shall return" we are faced with our own mortality and the consequences of sin. 


